Important Information



Online Application

- Easy & Simple Online Application (www.kauisp.com)
- Required documents: a copy of passport, academic transcript, photo
- Jan 15 – June 5, 2020



Admission

- Result will be notified within one week after your application package is received.
- KAU ID will be given before the program starts including confirmation of your course and dormitory selection.



Payment

- Guideline and invoice will be sent by email.
- Payment must be wire-transferred
- Payment should be made within 15 days after the admission is approved.



VISA

- Students do not need to obtain a visa if your country is under Designated Visa-Free Entry countries or Visa Waiver Agreements with Korea.

If your country is neither Designated Visa-Free Entry countries nor Visa Waiver Agreements with Korea, you will have to apply for D-2-8 VISA.

- KAU OIA will send you the COA(Certificate of Admission) and other related documents.
- Contact the Korean Embassy or Consulate in the country of your home university.
- Visa Processing time: Approximately 10 to 15 working days

* Please note that it might take more than 10 working days for the applications lodged by mail.
